Once again, The International Orthoptic Association is holding a photography contest to develop new promotional materials for our annual celebrations. We are inviting any member of the IOA to submit photos representing an image of our profession. This year's contest theme is:

"Reflections in Orthoptics".

The use of water, windows, mirrors or any type of reflective surface can change an image into a work of art. Reflections can completely alter an image from something fairly straightforward into something richer, abstract or otherwise more artistic. Reflection(s) can provide us with clarity, or better understanding to experiences or new information and ultimately progressive orthoptic science.

Our profession can and does blend science and art. How will you interpret this to show some direct relationship to orthoptic practice?

The winning submission will be used on all of our promotional materials for World Orthoptic Day. Please encourage your colleagues and students to get involved as this is one of our ways to showcase our profession on a global basis.

World Orthoptic Day 2018 Photo Contest Rules

2018 Rules & Regulations

ELIGIBILITY

This photography contest is open to all members of the International Orthoptic Association. The picture(s) submitted should be representative of World Orthoptic Day and is open to artistic interpretation. The submissions may be of individuals as long as each **individual who may be identified within the photograph has signed a release form (please see attached)**. Only submissions that have all of the required release forms signed and submitted will be eligible for the contest. The submissions do not have to be photographs of individuals and may be an artistic interpretation of World Orthoptic Day and the profession of Orthoptics.

FORMAT

Entries are to be digital photographs and submitted electronically as **jpeg files**. Content alteration of digital files is acceptable, including combining multiple photos. Cropping of photos is permitted, tonal or colour corrections are also acceptable. The entry must be accompanied by a signed release from the photographer (please see below) as well as all and any individuals who may be identified within the photograph (please see attached).

PUBLICATION

The winner's name and photograph(s) will be published on www.internationalorthoptics.org as well as on promotional material for World Orthoptic Day, 2018. A selection of winning entries may also be published on the International Orthoptic Association (IOA) website. The IOA reserves the non-exclusive right to publish any entry and/or use any entry in promotional and advertising materials. Photos published will be credited to the photographer.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top three chosen photos.

DEADLINE

All entries for the World Orthoptic Day photo contest should be emailed to: secretary@internationalorthoptics.org Online entries can be submitted starting February 1st, 2018 with a deadline of 11:59 PM (EST) May 1st, 2018. Finalists will be announced in early May 2018 to the winners directly as well as on the International Orthoptic Association website (www.internationalorthoptics.org) via email.

JUDGING

The winners will be selected by a panel of judges consisting of the IOA president and 2 Council of Management members. Decision of the judges is final.

Photo Contest: Rules, Terms and Conditions

ELIGIBILITY AND JUDGING:

To ensure eligibility for the contest, all entries must have a resolution of 6 million pixels or greater (6 megapixels) to be made available upon request. Images that do not meet this standard can still be judged, but may not be honored as a finalist in the competition (at the judges' sole discretion) if the photographer is unable or unavailable to provide the proper resolution when asked.

Any member of the International Orthoptic Association may submit a photograph, which they have taken personally, for the WOD contest,

Resolution can be calculated by multiplying the pixel width of the image with the pixel height. For example, a photograph taken with a 6-megapixel camera set for the highest resolution and best quality produces images approximately 2832 pixels by 2128 pixels, which are acceptable under the rules ($2832 \times 2128 = 6$ million).

Entries must be submitted electronically. Submissions may be watermarked if desired, but the watermark should be inconspicuous enough so as not to interfere with the judging of the photo. A watermarked photo might not be honored by the competition (at the judges' sole discretion) if the photographer is unable or unavailable to provide a pristine, watermark-free version of the image when asked.

Images will be judged on originality, composition, overall impact and artistic merit. The World Orthoptic Day Committee shall determine winner eligibility in its sole and absolute discretion. All decisions made by the judges are final.

Online entries can be submitted starting February 1st, 2018 with a deadline of 11:59 PM (EST) May 1st, 2018. Finalists will be announced in early May 2018 to the winners directly as well as on the International Orthoptic Association website (www.internationalorthoptics.org) via email.
